



Deer Hunt Rules and Regulations

1. Hunters are responsible for ensuring that they have the proper license. All State laws and permits are enforced and required, except as otherwise specified herein.
2. Modern Archery equipment only.
3. Youth between 10-17 years old must be supervised by an adult at all times.
4. Only deer may be harvested.
5. No Baiting.
6. Only two (2) deer may be harvested per hunt, and one (1) must be an antlerless deer.
7. Hunters will use DNR urban deer management tags.
8. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on Forsyth County property.
9. Hunters must remain in the designated area for the duration of the hunt. Forsyth County staff will escort hunters in and out of the hunting area.
10. Participants may only access the property during the specific dates and times determined by Forsyth County.
11. All hunters are required to have a working cell phone.
12. All hunters are required to always wear 500 square inches of "hunter orange" above the waist.
13. All hunting locations are assigned by lottery, and hunters will be taken to and picked up from their hunting locations by Forsyth County staff.
14. All hunters must remain in their stand for the first 2 hours of the morning hunt and be in their stand at least 2 hours before the end of the evening hunt.
15. All deer must be brought to the check station before field dressed by the hunter.
16. No tracking of deer will be allowed without assistance or permission of Forsyth County staff members.
17. Any hunter who violates state law or special regulations set forth by Forsyth County is subject to losing their hunting privileges on Forsyth County property, which will result in forfeiture of the hunt.
18. By signing the waiver, I hereby grant Forsyth County and its representatives' permission to take and publish photographs of me at this event.
19. Be advised that under O.C.G.A. § 51-3-22, Forsyth County shall not be liable for any injury or death of an individual entering our premises. By entering Forsyth County premises, you expressly assume all risks associated with such entry, including but not limited to the risk of injury or death.
20. All hunters must attend and complete the pre-hunt meeting scheduled by Forsyth County. Failure to attend or complete the entire meeting will result in disqualification from participation in the hunt. The pre-hunt meeting will cover essential safety protocols, designated hunting areas, and specific rules for the event.
