

CAMPGROUND RULES & REGULATIONS

We hope you enjoy your stay. Follow the rules below to have a safe and fun visit here on beautiful Lake Lanier.

CHECK-IN / CHECK-OUT

Check-in time is 3:00pm

All campers and visitors must register at the visitor center upon arrival.

Check-out time is 1:00pm.

An additional nightly rental fee will be charged for late departure.

Security gate requires a code for entry into the campground.

For emergencies or after business hours, please contact the Park Attendant at 770-205-6850 or dial 911.

CAMPGROUND RULES

Alcoholic beverages and intoxicants are prohibited.

Campsite occupancy is limited to a **maximum of 8 people and 3 vehicles.** Any additional vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas.

One camper, trailer or motor home is allowed per site.

All tents must be placed on the designated impact area. No more than 2 tents per site.

Quiet hours are from 10:00pm until 6:00am.

Unreasonable or excessive noise at any time is prohibited.

Pets must be kept on a leash not exceeding 10 feet in length.

Pets are not allowed in restrooms, playground areas, shelters or designated swim areas.

Fires must be confined in a designated fire ring or grill. Only dead wood on the ground may be collected for firewood. No chainsaws may be used.

VEHICLES

Vehicles may not be operated or parked off the roadway. Golf Carts are not permitted in the campground.

All vehicles must display a vehicle tag. Tags are obtained at the Visitor Center upon arrival.

TRASH & WASTE

The discharge of grey water and black water (sewage) is prohibited. Please use the dump station or call the Visitor Center for mobile dump service.

Deposit garbage in dumpsters located at various locations around the campground.

OTHER

Visitors of campers must depart the campground by 9:30 p.m. or when the camper checks out if prior to this time.

Length of stay is no longer than 14 days during any 30 consecutive day period.

Only adults (18 years or older) may rent a campsite. Minors may not be left in the campground without adult supervision.

Use of electric bikes, electric scooters, hoverboards, Onewheels, and electric skateboards are not permitted in the campground.

Children under the age of 16 must wear helmets when riding bikes, scooters and skateboards.

Please comply with all posted signage in the campground.
